

Passers-by, welcome!



The Haarlemsche Jachtclub (HJC) would like to welcome you as a guest at our beautiful and quietly located marina at the Mooie Nel in Haarlem. The HJC is an association founded in 1917 that has been welcoming guests for many years and where we do our best to make your stay as pleasant as possible.

Sailing Route

If you are sailing from the 'Grote Sluis' (Rijnlandsluis) in Spaarndam, then after approximately 650 m sail, go to port towards the 'Mooie Nel'. If sailing from Haarlem, 1,200 m after the 'Schoterbrug' go to starboard towards the 'Mooie Nel'. The HJC marina is located shortly on the 'Mooie Nel' on the starboard side

At the moment, the Buitenhuizerbrug across Zijkanaal C is completely blocked. This means that the maximum clearance height is limited to 6.82 metres. There is no prospect of an end date for the time being. The Schipholbrug on the eastern Ringvaart is also blocked. For up-to-date information see the website: www.vaarweginformatie.nl

Report

If you are planning to visit our marina, please contact the harbour master in advance on (0031 63371 6379). Upon arrival, please moor directly at the 'Meldsteiger' (reporting jetty), do not enter the harbour, unless previously agreed with the harbour master. If the harbour master is not available, or you are arriving late, you may moor your boat at the reporting jetty. Shore power is available and, the electricity is active. Please note, the maximum stay is 12 days.



Payment

For 2026, the mooring fee is €2.25 per metre per night. We kindly request payment in advance. You may pay by debit or credit card at the harbour master's office. Alternatively, if you are departing early, you can transfer the fee to account NL26 INGB 0000 101596 using the name of 'Haarlemsche Jachtclub'. Please include "Passant," your boat name, and your arrival date in the payment reference. Please also notify the harbor master by text or WhatsApp on (0031 63371 6379), confirming you have paid via bank transfer.

Facilities

The HJC offers various facilities for passers-by, including:

- Free electricity, tap water and Wi-Fi
- Free sanitary facilities and disabled toilet (available 24/7)
- Free rental bicycles.
- Waste containers for 1) residual waste, 2) paper & cardboard, 3) plastic & drink cartons, 4) glass, and 5) deposit bottles and cans, (proceeds from deposit items are donated to charity).
- A washing machine and dryer are located in the ladies' changing room (€ 5.00). Detergent is included and available from the harbor master.
- A waste water pump (free) and bilge pump (€ 5,00) are available on the reporting jetty.
- Hot and cold drinks, sweets and sandwiches are available in the clubhouse at a reasonable price when service is available.



Blue flag

Since 2020, the HJC has been awarded the Blue Flag, reflecting our commitment to the environment and sustainability. To help us maintain this status, please review the conditions and regulations posted on the port signs and in paragraph 6 of the port regulations on the HJC website.

Emergencies

How to act in the event of an emergency:

- Call the national emergency number **112** and provide:
 - 1) The required service (Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance);
 - 2) Your identity;
 - 3) Your location (Mooie Nelweg 101, 2031 BV Haarlem);
 - 4) The nature of the emergency,
- Then immediately call the harbor master on 0031 63371 6379 so that he can provide first aid and/or receive and guide the emergency services to the emergency.
- There is an AED right behind the main entrance of the clubhouse.

The clubhouse

The clubhouse is open daily from 08:00 to 17:00. During the summer season, we may remain open in the evening depending on interest and attendance. Additionally, every morning at 10:00 a.m. fresh coffee is available for both members and visitors for a small fee.

Entrance gate

The entrance gate can be opened from the outside using a code provided by the harbour master.

Dogs

There is an extensive off-leash area located to the left. Please ensure your dog remains on a leash at all times while at the marina. Additionally, we kindly ask that you only allow your pet to relieve itself outside the marina.

Pavilion Loef

When you exit the harbour through the entrance gate and walk 130 metres to the left, you will find 'Paviljoen Loef'. It is an excellent spot for lunch, dinner, or drinks with a view of the Mooie Nel. Please refer to the website www.paviljoenloef.nl for opening hours.

Cycling routes

Shops and groceries: From the harbour, cycle along the Mooie Nelweg to the A. Hofmanweg. Turn right and follow the bend towards the Waarderweg, then turn right at the traffic lights. After crossing the bridge over the Spaarne river, keep right and after approximately 200 m turn left at the traffic lights onto the Jan Gijzenkade. After approximately 700 m, you will find a supermarket (Dekamarkt), an ATM, various shops, and a swimming pool [De Planeet](#).

Haarlem Centre Follow the same route as described above until you cross the bridge over the Spaarne river. At the traffic lights, turn left and continue with the river on your left to reach the Haarlem city center.

Taxi and public transport

- The closest train station is Spaarnwoude Station, 3.3 km away otherwise Haarlem Central Station is 4.9 km.
- The nearest bus station is at the Schoterweg in Haarlem-Noord, 3.8 km from the harbour.

Historic Haarlem is an atmospheric, cozy and versatile city that is well worth exploring. There are beautiful city walks, with courtyard views and interesting museums. We recommend visiting the [Frans Hals Museum](#) and the [Teylers Museum](#), as well as the beautiful St. Bavo church and the Town Hall located on the Grote Markt. Beyond its rich history, art and culture, Haarlem offers excellent shopping, several cinemas and a wide choice of restaurants and cafes.
